Commercial Invoices

Documents needed:

- 1- The original invoice legalised by the Australian Arab Chamber of Commerce and Industry Inc. and the office of the Department of Foreign Affairs and Trade in the state or the New Zealand Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Trade.
- 2- The certificate of origin legalised by the Department of Foreign Affairs and Trade in the state or the New Zealand Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Trade.
- 3- Legalisation fee for an invoice is 1% of the invoice value, as long as the fee is not less than AU\$ 21.00 nor over AU\$ 2030.00. Example: If the invoice value is US\$ 1000.00 the fee would be AU\$ 21.00.
 You can fax or e-mail the embassy to know about the exact amount of the fees.
- 4- Legalisation fee for a certificate of origin is AU\$ 22.00 if it does not contain a value.
- 5- Legalisation fee for any other enclosed document is AU\$ 14.00. A health certificate, phytosanitary certificate or animal health certificate is to be attached with the invoice if the product is food, medication or chemicals such as fertilisers.
- 6- All fees should be paid by one money order or company cheque in the name of the Syrian Embassy. (Personal cheques are not accepted).
